Suggested Documents to Use to Develop Your Leave-Behind Materials: Please use the following documents to develop your brief presentation and leave-behind materials for your legislative-office visits.

1. 2018 Florida [Legislative Platform](#) for Arts & Culture;
2. Arts & Economic Prosperity 5 Studies for [Florida](#) and [Your County](#) — access all Florida reports [here](#) and just click your county to access its AEP5-study summary, if available;
3. [2017 Creative Industries Reports](#) — access Florida American for the Arts creative industry report for your county;
4. Information about your organization, arts and cultural information about [your community](#), local jobs in arts and culture, local arts economic impact figures, how much matching money DCA grants leverage, etc.;
5. List of qualified Division of Cultural Affairs (DCA) 2018 - 2019 recommended grant applicants based in your county. Access your county list under [Platform Alert that has just your county](#) of recommended 2018-2019 DCA grants linked within the Alert for you to download and print; and
6. Bring plenty of your business cards.



Give yourself PLENTY of TIME. It will take you longer than you think to park, get through security, and to the 22nd floor of the Capitol.

To get into the Capitol Complex, **you have to go through security**; so, again, give yourself plenty of time to get through security and get to the 22nd floor and/or your legislative meetings.



Note before you get on one of the **elevators**, **make sure it takes you to the 22nd floor** of the Capitol. There are only a couple of elevators that will take you directly to the 22nd floor.
