Resources for You to Use During the 2018 Elections:

	<p>1. Make sure you're registered to vote.</p>	<p>Update or Register here.</p>
	<p>2. Put the election dates on your calendar and make sure you vote: Primary — August 28 AND General Election — November 6</p>	<p>Information for voters.</p>
	<p>3. Learn YOUR DISTRICT #s for those candidates who are already elected or who are still in their respective races for the U.S. House, Florida Senate, and Florida House and who do or will represent you and your county. The Excel files that you have access to in #4 below are listed by district # order.</p>	<p>Your districts here. Districts for your county.</p>
	<p>4. Invest some time to learn about the candidates who are running for STATEWIDE OFFICE. Focus FIRST on those candidates on the Primary Ballot and then on the General Election Ballot: explore their Websites, learn how much they have raised in campaign contributions, get access to their Twitter handles, Facebook, addresses, etc. Connect with them — all contact information is here.</p>	<p>Quick Look at STATUS by Counties and District #s Excel Files Linked Here — includes comprehensive information on each candidate.</p>
